Welcome to Kirkenes

– frontier town at 70°North 30°East

There is a never-ending range of activities in the frontier town of Kirkenes. Take part in one or more of the scheduled excursions on offer and gain an insight into the town's rich culture and history.

POPULATION: Kirkenes and Sør-Varanger municipalities have a total of 9,500 inhabitants. Sør-Varanger municipality is the same size as the region of Vestfold in southern Norway, 3,670 km². Kirkenes is as far east as Istanbul and Cairo, and as far north as Point Barrow in Alaska.

CLIMATE: The dark season in Kirkenes lasts from 27 November to 16 January. During this period, the sun does not appear over the horizon and there are only a few hours of daylight in the middle of the day. Average temperatures in Kirkenes: December: -11°C, January: -13°C,

February: -10°C, March: -4.5°C, April: -1°C

SHOPPING: Kirkenes has shopping centres and a number of shops where you can buy most goods and services.

ENTERTAINMENT: Pubs: Ritz, Ofelas, Rallaren Pub, Havna Pub, Henry's Bar (Rica Arctic Hotel), Bar at Rica Hotel Kirkenes

OTHER: Cinema, fitness centre, cross-country skiing and downhill skiing.

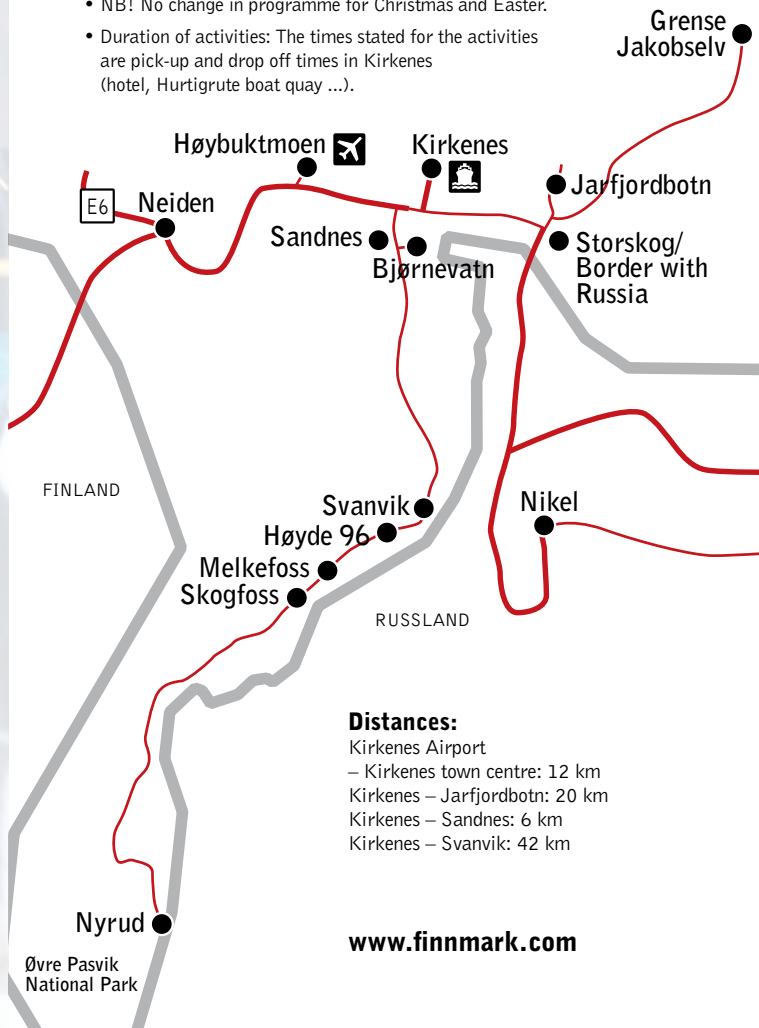

Activities can be booked at the reception desk in your hotel, at the Tourist Information office or directly with the organiser up to one day in advance (before 15.00).

- **CANCELLATION:** activities must be cancelled one day in advance by 15.00, otherwise you will be charged 100%.
- No minimum number of participants.
- Thermal suit, shoes, hat/helmet and gloves are included in the price for the dog-sledge and snow mobile trips. We recommend thermal underwear, woollen/fleece sweater, tracksuit trousers, warm socks and a scarf.
- The organisers have the right to cancel all excursions in the event of adverse weather or driving conditions.
- We cannot guarantee a sighting of the Northern Lights – this relies on weather conditions.
- **NB!** Not all activities are available for the entire period from 01.12.08–30.04.09. Check individual dates.
- **NB!** No change in programme for Christmas and Easter.
